3 Selection Process:

(1) First selection: Applicant screening

(We will ask you to submit your certificates after the second selection stage.)

- (2) Second selection: Interview (only those who passed the first selection stage)

5 Working Conditions:

(1) Wages: An hourly wage will be paid according to Minato City's regulations and rules for instructors working in Minato City public elementary schools.

Example of yearly wage from 2025 (Including to regional allowance equivalent amount) ¥1,956/h - ¥3,487/h (subject to years of experience as a teacher)

Transportation fees (maximum ¥55,000 per month) will be provided.

If the requirements are met, an end of term bonus and diligence bonus will also be paid. Salaries are based on work performance and paid the following month. (e.g. the salary for work performed in April will be paid in May.)

- (2) 5 days a week from Monday to Friday (35 hours or less /week) Saturday classes are held 2 times per month (regular working days)
- (3) If the requirements are met, you must enroll in the social insurance system.

(5) Job Duties:

- 1. Assisting in international classes with a Japanese homeroom teacher as an international class teacher.
- 2. Team teaching subjects involving practical skills (science, music, arts & crafts, P.E. and home economics) in English with a Japanese homeroom teacher.
- 3. Teaching math, languages and arts to small groups of foreign students in English according to the Japanese curriculum. Teaching basic English to small groups of students so that they can study math, science and social studies in English.
- 4. Teaching basic Japanese to foreign students.
- 5. Drawing up yearly lesson plans, teaching materials, English report cards, etc. related to the educational guidance of foreign students.
- 6. Translating letters from the school or PTA for foreign parents.
- 7. Advising foreign students and parents on school matters.
- 8. Other tasks assigned by the Minato City Secretariat of the Board of Education that are related to international classes.
