

1 Toranomon Hills Mori Tower



The Toranomon Hills Mori Tower skyscraper complex stretches 247m into the sky and contains offices, a hotel, and residential and commercial spaces. In front of the entrance lies Oval Square, a 6,000 square meter outdoor space.

3 Atago Jinja Shrine



Located on at the peak of Mt. Atago (26m above sea level), this shrine is believed by many to ward off fires. The steeper hill has an 86-step stone stairway on a 40 degree incline that folk legend says Magaki Heikuro rode up and down on his horse in 1630.
