Old Shimbashi Station 📙 Shimbashi SL Square 🚾 Railway History Exhibition Hall Popular meeting spot

Covers the history of railways and Shiodome (home to Japan's first terminal)

The site of Japan's first railway terminal, Shimbashi Teishajō, which began operation in 1872. The current building's exterior is a reproduction of the original station. The exhibition room features original relics, such as train-car teapots excavated from the site, as well as foundation stones from the original building. *Due to removal of tenants, the shared walkway with ramp that leads to the exhibition room is currently unavailable. Wheelchair access is temporarily unavailable (as of February 2023).




A new symbol for international Tokyo

Atago-jinja Shrine

Famous for stone steps of career

Located at the summit of Mt. Atago (26m high), the highest in Tokyo's 23 districts and a natural topographical feature, it enshrined the god for protection against fire in the Edo period. Said to be an excellent spot with the best view of the Edo, the painter Hiroshige Utagawa used it as a theme of his printmaking.
