Disaster Prevention App

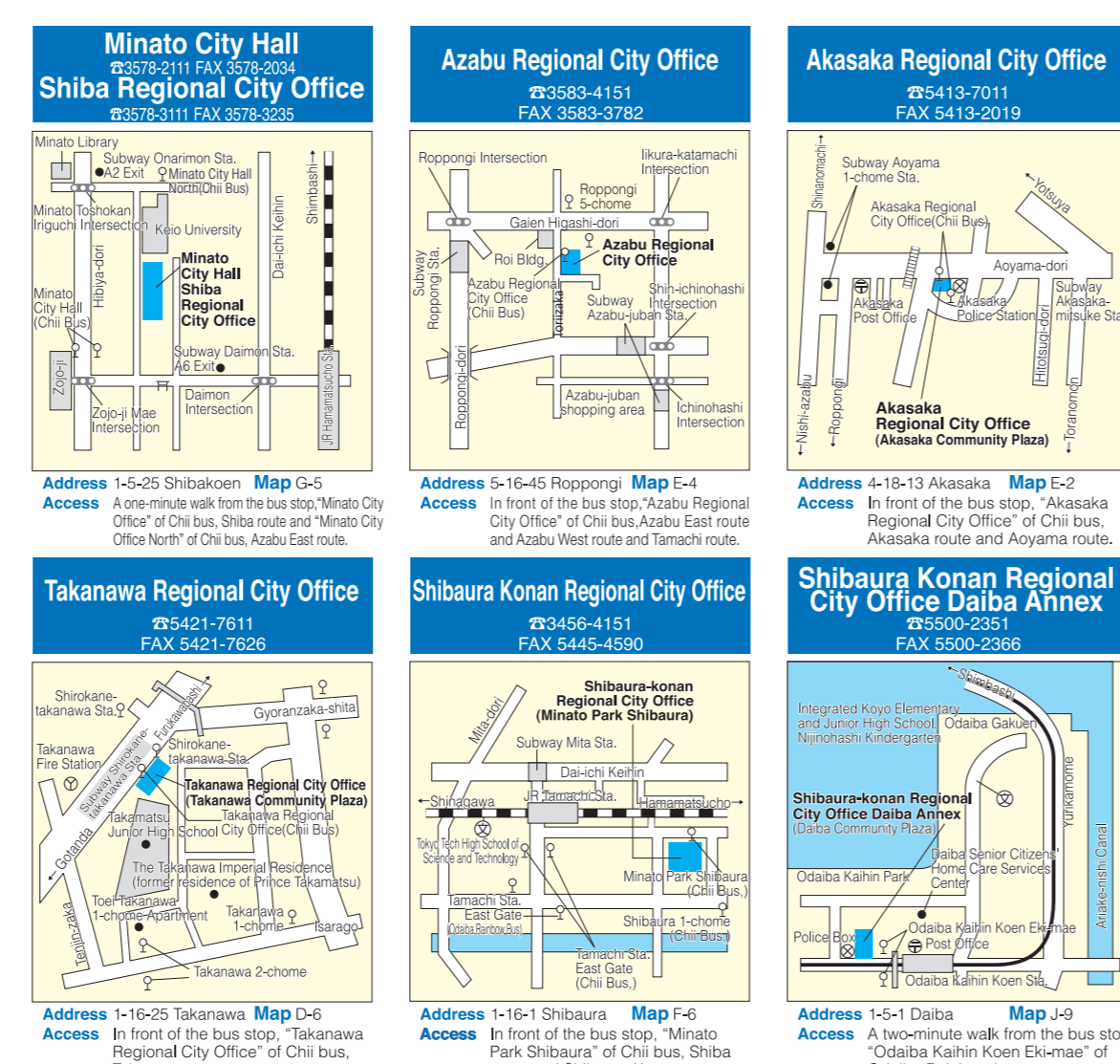

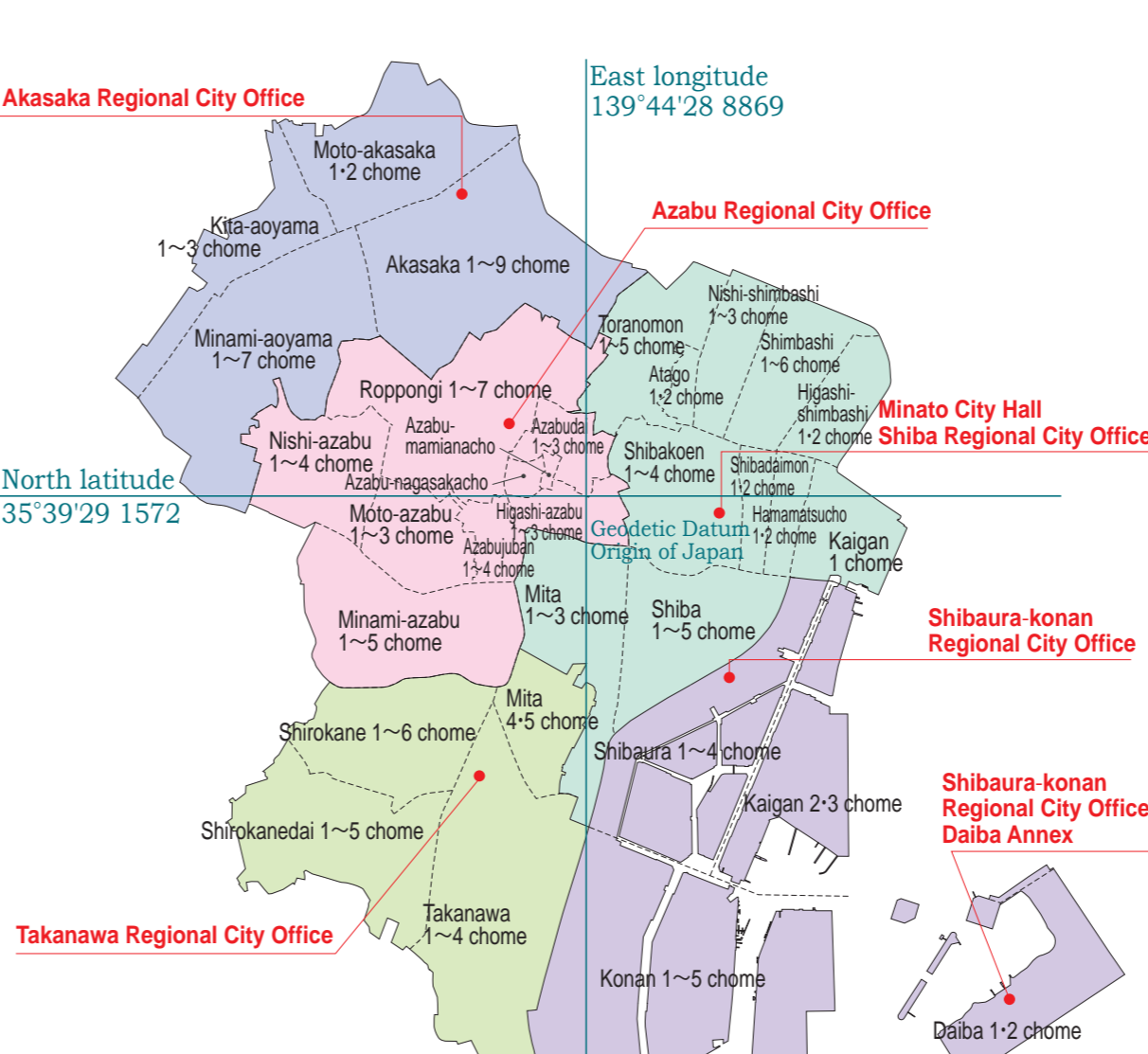


City Hall and Regional City Offices and Public Health Center



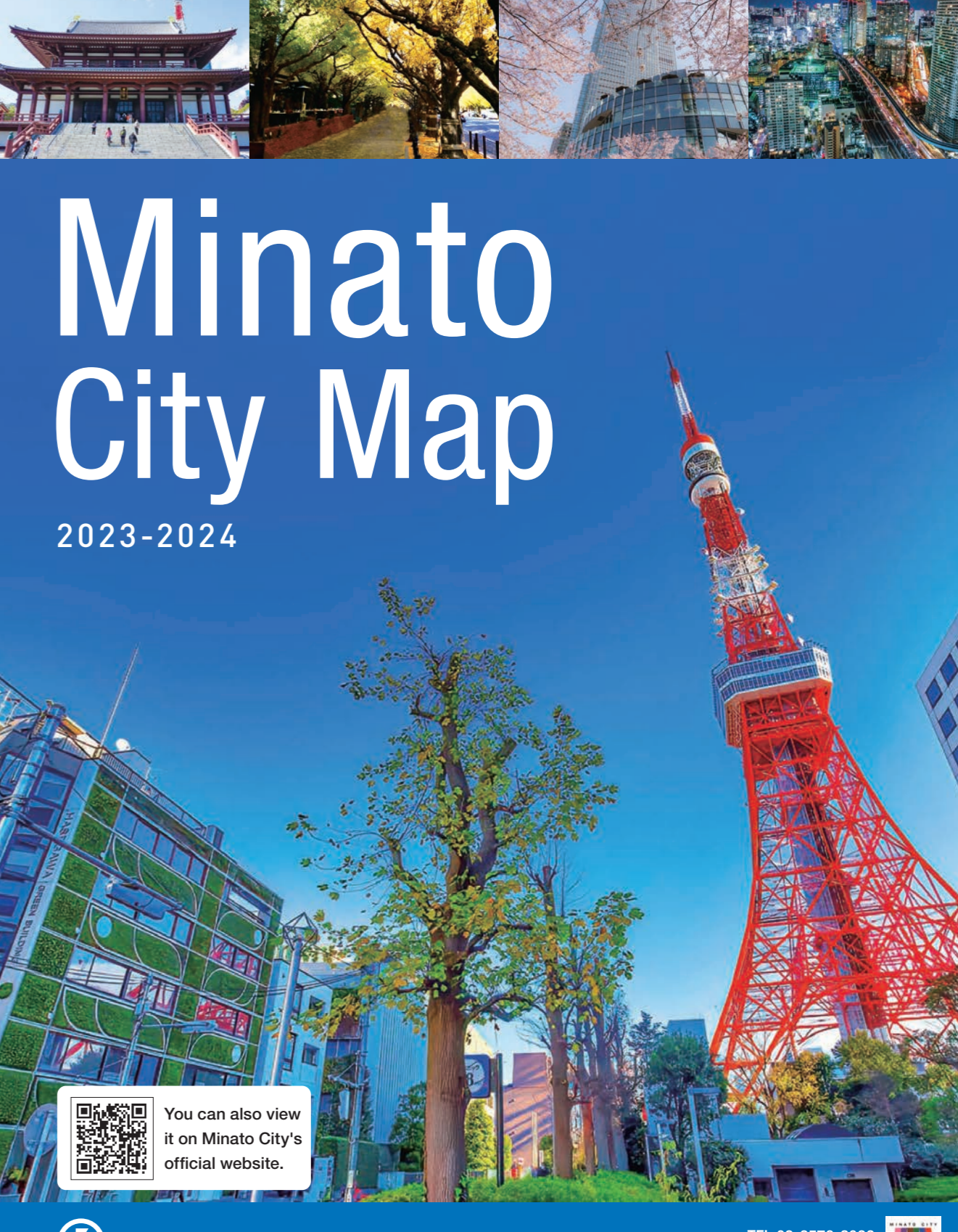
