Issuance of COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate

There are two types of vaccination certificates—for both overseas and domestic, and for domestic. Select the vaccination certificate for your purpose. **Eligibility:** People who have received their vaccinations in Japan using vaccination tickets issued by Minato City.

For Electronic Vaccination Certificate

People who hold a My Number Card can use the dedicated app, COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate App provided by the Government of Japan for the issuance of their vaccination certificates.

For people who do not have a My number Card, an electronic vaccination certificate cannot be issued. Paper vaccination certificate will be issued.

For Paper Vaccination Certificate

- People Who Plan to Travel Abroad
 A vaccination certificate for both overseas and domestic can be issued. The vaccination certificate can be issued by postal mail application, electronic application, or by the counter.
- 2. People Who Do Not Plan to Travel Abroad A vaccination certificate for domestic can be issued. The vaccination

certificate can be issued by postal mail application or by electronic application.

It takes about 1 to 2 weeks for the issuance after application.

Note

- A vaccination certificate cannot be issued for vaccinations outside of Japan or for vaccinations that are not approval in Japan.
- The consultation counter for applying the vaccination certificate is at the Minato Public Health Center. It cannot be accepted at the City Hall or Regional City Offices. Before coming, make a reservation in advance via the website at https://coubic.com/minato-city/556018.

Childbirth Expense **Subsidies**

Eligibility

All of the following must apply.

- 1. The child's mother/father must have an address and have resided in Minato City for one or more years before the date of filing a subsidy application.
- 2. The child has lived in Minato City with the mother/father from the date of birth. *However, there is an exception when both parents are foreign nationals and given birth outside Japan.
- 3. The mother of the child must be enrolled in a Japanese public health insurance.
- 4. The application must be submitted within one year from the date of birth.

Summary of the subsidy

Minato City provides a subsidy to the balance of expenses for the child's delivery expense and for the childbirth hospitalization up to ¥730,000, after deducting the childbirth allowance received.

The additional amount for mothers giving birth to more than one child is up to ¥400,000.

Required documents

- 1. Copies of receipts and of a detailed statement of childbirth costs issued by the
 - If childbirth takes place overseas, a translated document is necessary.
- 2. A copy of the mother's health insurance card
- 3. A copy of the document of consent for the direct childbirth lump-sum allowance payment system or a copy of the notice of the childbirth lump-sum allowance determination notice issued by the enrolled health insurance union

Other required documents

If an additional payment to the childbirth lump-sum allowance is/has been provided, a copy of the determination notice for the additional payment must be submitted. If childbirth is performed by caesarean section, etc., and the applicant is eligible for high-cost medical care benefits, a copy of the benefit determination notice must be

For more information on other required documents, please confirm with the health insurance that you are enrolled.

Application

Fill in a childbirth expenses subsidy application form and submit the required documents either at the Health and Welfare Subsection of Regional City Offices, or via postal mail to the Children's Benefit Subsection, Minato City Hall, 105-8511. *The childbirth expenses subsidy application form is available at the Children's Benefit Subsection on the seventh floor of Minato City Hall and at the Health and Welfare Subsection of Regional City Offices. It can also be downloaded from the Minato City Web.
