

Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games



令和3(2021)年9月5日、東京2020パラリンピック競技大会 の競技日程の最後を飾った陸上競技(マラソン)において、ランナーが港 区を走行しました。

JR新橋駅近くの外堀通りを通過し、西新橋交差点を日比谷通りに沿っ て南下したランナーたちは、ここ区立芝公園付近で折り返し、フィニッシュ の国立競技場 (オリンピックスタジアム) に向けて走り抜けていきました。

On September 5, 2021, runners ran through Minato City in the Athletics Marathon, the final event of the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games.

After passing Sotobori Street near JR Shimbashi Station, the runners headed south along Hibiya Street at the Nishi-Shimbashi intersection, turned around near Minato City Shiba Park, and headed towards the finish line at the Olympic

Despite COVID-19 measures preventing spectators from cheering on runners at the roadside, the sight of the runners determination was televised worldwide, causing people around the world to feel emotional and inspired, and bringing excitement to the final day of the Games.
