Pretty Guardian Sailor Moon

Usagi Tsukino is just a normal girl who is a bit clumsy and a crybaby. However, Usagi begins to awaken to her destiny when she meets Luna, a talking black cat with a crescent moon-shaped mark on her forehead. After learning she is destined to find the Legendary Silver Crystal and protect the Moon Princess, Usagi and her friends, the Sailor Guardians, are drawn into a cruel battle.

The setting of the story, which moves between scenes of peaceful everyday life and dramatic battles, is Minato City. One example is the Azabujuban area, where you

can feel the international atmosphere of the embassies, along with the energy of the vibrant shopping district and its mix of both long-established and new shops. This area frequently appears in scenes of daily life where Usagi and her friends go to the arcade or meet up with each other.

Other spots around the city, such as Tokyo Tower, the symbol of Minato City, or Shiba Park, known as a soothing oasis in the center of the metropolis, frequently appear in various scenes, making you feel as though you have slipped into the world of Pretty Guardian Sailor Moon.



## Characters

### SAILOR MOON (Usagi Tsukino)



The mystical guardian who protects the moon, the planet of love and justice. In a previous life she was Princess Serenity of the Silver Millennium in the moon. Before transformation, Usagi is usually clumsy and a crybaby. However, she is full of inviting receptivity and compassion, and as a princess she is not only protected, but also confronts her enemies on her own.

### SAILOR JUPITER (Makoto Kino)



The protector of the planet of thunder, Jupiter, guardian of protection. Before transformation, Makoto Kino is a hopelessly romantic girl who excels in power and athleticism. But also loves cooking and gardening. She takes the initiative to make breakthroughs on the front lines by utilising her offensive power with the energy of lightning.

### SAILOR MERCURY (Ami Mizuno)



The protector of the planet of water, Mercury, guardian of wisdom. Before transformation, Ami Mizuno is a genius girl with a rumoured IQ of 300. As the brain of the Sailor Guardians, she calmly analyses the war situation and leads the team to victory.

### SAILOR VENUS (Minako Aino)



The protector of the planet of beauty, Venus, guardian of love. Before transformation, Minako Aino is a following trends girl. Her dream is to become an idol. Before joining the team as Venus, she was a leader of the guardians, secretly active as Sailor V, the beautiful Sailor Guardian of justice.

### SAILOR MARS (Rei Hino)



The protector of the planet of fire, Mars, guardian of war. Before transformation, Rei Hino is a psychic girl who served as a Shinto priestess at the Hikawa shrine, normally, she is a quiet girl with a mysterious mood, but when push comes to shove, she leads the team with a will stronger than anyone else.

### TUXEDO MASK (Mamoru Chiba)



As Tuxedo Mask he helps out Sailor Moon when she's in a tight spot. He is Usagi's fated lover and in his past life was the prince of the Earth Kingdom, Prince Endymion.

### Minato City Bicycle Sharing

Bicycle sharing is a service that allows users to borrow and return bicycles from any of the cycle ports\* in the community. You can borrow a bicycle at the port when you want to ride it and return it to a port where you want to go. The bicycles are electric bicycles for easy transportation even on hills.

\*Cycle ports (ports) are unmanned bicycle parking facilities located on privately-owned land or sidewalks, etc., where bicycles can be rented and returned.

### How to Use

Registration or purchase of a one-day pass is required to use bicycle sharing.

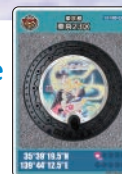

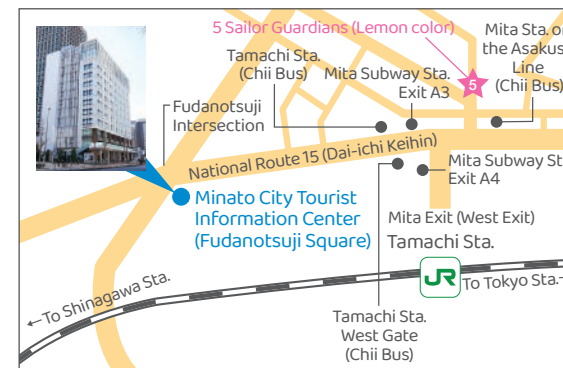

### ★ Sailor Moon & Tuxedo Mask

Location: At the entrance to Azabujuban Shotengai (Shopping Street) [2-1 Azabujuban]

The place of the fated reunion between Usagi Tsukino (Sailor Moon) and Mamoru Chiba (Tuxedo Mask). There are many sacred spots to visit here, from the places where Usagi and her friends lived, to shops that appear in the series and stores visited by the author Naoko Takeuchi at the time.

The manhole cover is in front of the primary school and kindergarten!



### ★ Usagi, Ami, Rei, Makoto & Minako

Location: In front of Toyo Eiwa Jogakuin Primary School and Kindergarten [5-6-14 Roppongi]

Toyo Eiwa Jogakuin Junior High School is said to be the model for T.A. Private Girls' Academy, the school attended by Rei Hino (Sailor Mars), a miko (Priestess) and the granddaughter of the chief priest of Hikawa Shrine. This manhole cover features a red background, the signature color of Sailor Mars.

### ★ 5 Sailor Guardians (Fresh greenery)

Location: Near Tokyo Tower (in front of Shiba Water Supply Station) [3-6-7 Shibakoen]

One of Minato City's famous landmarks, Tokyo Tower frequently appears in Pretty Guardian Sailor Moon. It is the place where the Legendary Silver Crystal appeared and Usagi's past incarnation as the Moon Princess is first revealed, as well as the site of several battles. This manhole cover features a green background, the signature color of Sailor Jupiter.

The manhole cover is in front of Shiba Water Supply Station!



### ★ 5 Sailor Guardians (Blue)

Location: Near Shiba Park (in front of Minato Library) [3-2-25 Shibakoen]

Shiba Koen Junior High School, the fictional junior high school attended by Minako Aino (Sailor Venus), the leader of the four Sailor Guardians who protect the Moon Princess, was located near Shiba Park. This manhole cover features a blue background, the signature color of Sailor Mercury.



### ★ 5 Sailor Guardians (Lemon color)

Location: At the entrance to Keio Nakadori Shotengai (Shopping Street) [5-20 Shiba]

Before "Pretty Guardian Sailor Moon," the series' author Naoko Takeuchi also wrote "Code Name: Sailor V." Its protagonist Minako Aino (Sailor Venus) first appeared here. This manhole cover features a yellow background, the signature color of Sailor Venus.



## Map of Azabujuban Spots with Connections to Pretty Guardian Sailor Moon

### Sacred Spot 1

#### McDonald's Azabujuban

This place near the entrance to the Azabujuban Shotengai appears in the series as Game Center Crown where Usagi and friends hang out. The original model for the arcade was a pachinko parlor named Crown, which occupied the spot before McDonald's was built.

### Sacred Spot 2

#### Ichihashi Park

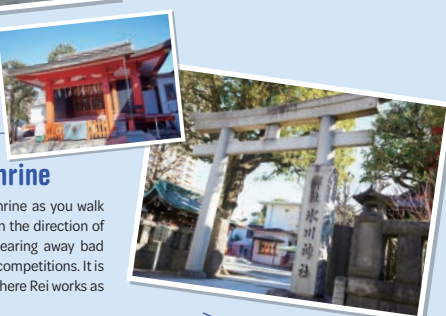
This park often appears in scenes where Chibi-Usa travels back and forth from the future. It has since been renovated, but some of the fountains still retain their original appearance.



### Sacred Spot 3

#### Azabu Hikawa Shrine

You will find Azabu Hikawa Shrine as you walk down Azabujuban Shotengai in the direction of Moto-Azabu, renowned for clearing away bad luck and bringing good luck in competitions. It is the model for Hikawa Shrine where Rei works as a miko (Priestess).

### Sacred Spot 4

#### Kaleidoscope Specialty Shop Kaleidoscope Mukashi-Kan

The first kaleidoscope specialty shop in Japan. It appears in the series as the shop where Mamoru buys Usagi and Chibi-Usa matching kaleidoscopes, making it a popular spot with visiting fans from Japan and overseas.



### Sacred Spot 5

#### Naniwaya Sohonten

A venerable taiyaki shop established in 1909, which Naoko Takeuchi is said to have frequented. Freshly baked taiyaki made by the traditional method with adzuki beans from Tokachi in Hokkaido are the perfect accompaniment to a pilgrimage to the sacred spots.



### Sacred Spot 6

#### Hiranoya Paper & Stationery Store

Azabujuban Shotengai is the model for Usagi and friends' home ground and Juban Shopping Street. Hiranoya Paper & Stationery Store, located in one of the corners, is a historic stationery store established in 1929. Naoko Takeuchi used to frequent it while writing Pretty Guardian Sailor Moon.



### Sacred Spot 7

#### Sendaizaka-ue Bus Stop

Sendaizaka-ue Bus Stop is located at a 5-way intersection. In the series, getting on the "Six O'clock Demon Bus" will take you to a sixth road. Do you have the courage to try it?
