Notice of a Public Lecture on Disability Awareness and Briefing on the Development Progress of the Tentatively Named Minato City Minami-Azabu Group Home.

Part 1 Public Lecture: Disability Awareness

- The group home for persons with disabilities planned for this site is intended to accommodate persons with significant intellectual disabilities and severe behavioral disorders who may require specialized support.
- To promote “coexistence” so that those living in or around the group home can continue to live freely and with peace of mind in their community, Ms. ISHIWATA Kazumi, a long-time disability welfare advocate, will share her insights.

Professor Ishiwata has over 10 years of experience working at rehabilitation centers in Saitama Prefecture and Yokohama City and has taught disability welfare and human rights at Toyo Eiwa University and other institutions.

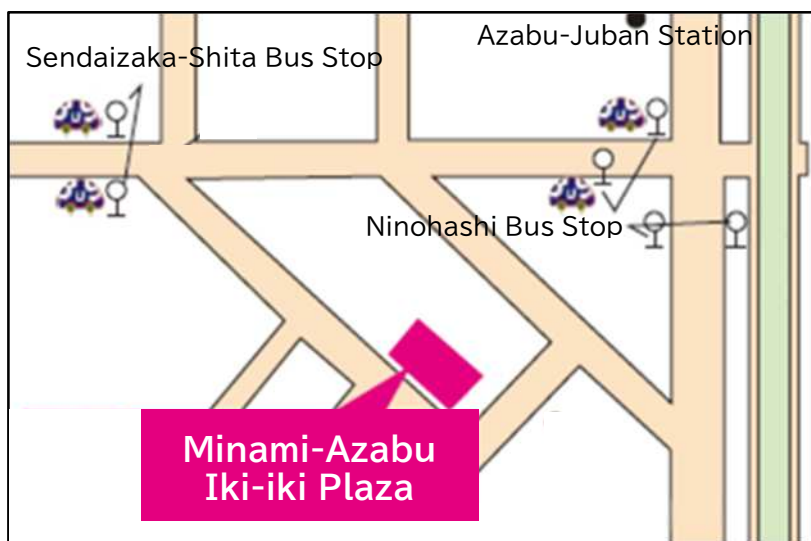
