POINT!

Use an elevator at Shinagawa Station Konan exit to get to the ground floor.



J-1 Shinagawa Season Terrace

Duration 40 minutes

Space where city and nature coexist

High-rise building with offices, restaurants, merchandising, and clinics has a vast green area, and the seasonal scenery offers visitors comfort and peace. It is also directly connected to Shibaura Central Park, creating an integrated bustle.



J-2 Shibaura Central Park

Duration 20 minutes

Observing living creatures at the botanical garden of wetlands

The park has a botanical garden of wetlands, fountain, lawn open space with wooden playground equipment, and dog-run. In the rose garden, many rose trees have been planted. The best time to see is around May and October.

J-4 Konan Ryokusui Park

J-3 Museum of Marine Science, Tokyo University of Marine Science and Technology

There is a steep uphill road before the bridge (4° gradient).

Pass under the bridge.

Use a slope to get from the canal to the road.

J-3 Museum of Marine Science, Tokyo University of Marine Science and Technology

Duration 40 minutes

A natural history museum displaying marine specimens

Located on the Tokyo University of Marine Science and Technology campus, this museum was renovated in 2016. Approximately 2,000 exhibits are on display, including a full dwarf minke whale skeleton, marine specimens, and mounted penguins, earless seals, sea turtles and other creatures.

Groups of 20 or more require a reservation.

Closed: Saturdays (the whale gallery is open), Sundays, public holidays, exam periods, museum inspection days, etc. Admission: Free

POINT!
The inside of the building is wide, so you can relax and look around.



J-4 Konan Ryokusui Park

Duration 20 minutes

Waterside space where you can experience nature

Inside the park, there are trees that colour differently in each season, fountains nature observation ponds (biotope), and scenic plaza where you can interact with nature and water. There are also disaster-response facilities. From inside the park, you can also see the Tokyo Monorail and Shinkansen.
