A-1 Kyu-Shiba-Rikyu Gardens

Duration **60** minutes

POINT!
There is a garden map outlining the suggested route for wheelchair users.



A gorgeous stone arrangement reflects the artistic sensibility of the Edo period

This well-known garden conveys a glimpse of a feudal lord's garden from the early Edo period. This garden embodies the characteristics of a strolling garden, featuring an exceptionally well-designed layout centered around a large pond and rock formations, and has been designated as one of the "scenic beauties" of Japan.

A-2 Shiba-daijingu Shrine (great shrine)

Duration **10** minutes

'Chigibako', popular for women, is recommended

Popular in Shiba-daijingu (great shrine), 'Chigibako' is said to be a lucky charm for women to have a happy life with plenty of clothing (1,000 kimonos), and to be blessed with good matches.

A-3 Zojo-ji Temple

Duration **30** minutes

Majestic temple located in the centre of Tokyo

You can enjoy a long walk through the large garden with a sense of freedom. Many temple treasures are located here, including one of the oldest wooden buildings in Tokyo, Sangedatsumon Gate (currently being renovated), and other important national cultural properties.

A-4 Tokyo Tower

Duration **60** minutes

Japan's foremost tourist attraction

The soaring, 333 m tall symbol of Tokyo. This radio tower, with its observation deck, was completed in 1958. Tower lights change depending on the season, with cool lights in summer and warm motifs in winter.

One of Japan's first public parks, Shiba Park was created in 1873 as one of five designated parks by the Meiji government. This park winds around Zojo-ji Temple and can be enjoyed in all seasons.
