## Sweeping views of Tokyo Bay: Enjoy the sea breeze, along with the latest that Minato City has to offer

- Start** Toei Asakusa / Ōedo Line  
Daimon Sta. Exit B4
- L-1** Tokyo Port City Takeshiba  
about 430m ⌚ about 7 minutes
- L-2** WATERS takeshiba  
about 180m ⌚ about 3 minutes
- L-3** Takeshiba Passenger Ship Terminal  
about 220m ⌚ about 4 minutes
- L-4** Hi-NODE TOKYO HINODE PIER  
about 540m ⌚ about 9 minutes
- L-5** Seavans Amall  
about 120m ⌚ about 2 minutes
- L-6** BLUE FRONT SHIBAURA / TOWER S  
about 520m ⌚ about 9 minutes
- Goal** JR / Tokyo Monorail Haneda Airport Line  
Hamamatsucho Sta. South Exit

#### Course Feature

There is a large hill between Takeshiba Passenger Ship Terminal and Hi-NODE, but overall the route is relatively flat.

**POINT!**  
An elevator located indoors provides access to Skip Terrace.



#### Break

The facility includes stores (Islands Shop, Shop Takeshiba), a cafe (Harbor), and Shichitou Credit Association (ATM).



### L-4 Hi-NODE TOKYO HINODE PIER

An elegant restaurant with views of Tokyo Bay  
The Hi-NODE complex includes an elegant cafe, terrace-side barbecue and open lawns. Water buses and bay cruises also embark from the pier, for those interested in boat voyages.



Differs by wharf and restaurant.

### L-5 Seavans Amall

An atrium with distinctive paired towers  
Located between Seavans Building N and Building S, which overlook the canals, Seavans Amall includes shops, restaurants and other services. There are also many open spaces for visitors to sit and relax. Amall is covered with a glass-dome ceiling to let in light, creating a green and open atmosphere.

### L-6 BLUE FRONT SHIBAURA/TOWER S

Sky, Sea, and Greenery: A Mega-Complex in the Bay Area  
BLUE FRONT SHIBAURA is located in central Tokyo, but offers abundant greenery, canals, and open, refreshing waterfront atmospheres such as Tokyo Bay. It is a large-scale mixed-use complex made up of hotels, offices, commercial spaces, and residences, and the first of its twin towers, TOWER S, opened in September 2025. TOWER N is scheduled to be completed in 2030.

### L-1 Tokyo Port City Takeshiba

A modern urban terrace reminiscent of terraced rice fields  
Tokyo Port City is a smart-city complex that incorporates the latest technologies. Skip Terrace, located on the 2nd to 6th floors of the office tower, features "New Eight Views of Takeshiba." The facility strives to create lush environments and share biodiversity initiatives.

### L-2 WATERS takeshiba

Tokyo's waterfront is just 6 minutes from Hamamatsucho Station  
A complex developed by JR-East, including hotels, theaters, shopping facilities and offices, that opened in October 2020. Due to its central location by the sea, it is a popular place to relax without needing to leave the city.

### L-3 Takeshiba Passenger Ship Terminal

A popular spot to view the sun set, with numerous benches lining the deck  
Takeshiba Passenger Ship Terminal is a gateway to the Izu and Ogasawara Islands. Summer pleasure cruises also use the port to embark and disembark.
