国民健康保険料の免除期間

- その年度に納める保険料の所得割額と均等割額から、出産被保険者の出産予定月(又は出産月)の前月から出産予定月(又は出産月)の翌々月(以下「産前産後期間」といいます。)相当分が減額されます。
 - ※ 保険料が最高限度額の世帯については、軽減を適用しても減額とならない場合があります。

Waiver of National Health Insurance premiums for the period before and after childbirth (four months)!

Eligibility/Application period

- Those covered by National Health Insurance and who are due to give birth or already gave birth after November 1, 2023, are eligible.
 - Births after 85 days of pregnancy (four months of pregnancy) are eligible (including stillbirths, miscarriages, premature deliveries, and artificial termination of pregnancy).
- Applications can be submitted from six months before the due date of delivery. Please hand in applications as soon as
 you can after delivery. *With the advent of expiry of right to do premium assessment, change of premium can not be
 done.

Waiver period for National Health Insurance premiums

- For those who are due to give birth covered by National Health Insurance, Deduction equivalent to the amount of premiums from the month before the expected month of delivery (or month of delivery) to two months after the expected month of delivery (or month of delivery) (hereafter, "prenatal and postnatal period"), from the amounts of insurance premium on per income and per capita basis paid during that fiscal year.
- *For household whose premium is the maximum, reduction can not always be done, if apply for reduce.
