The amounts of Minato City's resources and waste have not changed much over the past few years, but according to the Waste Survey conducted by the City in 2018, recyclable materials such as paper and plastics are included in large quantities in combustible waste, which make up the largest part of household waste. To reduce the amount of waste and to effectively use resources, please follow the rules for sorting recyclables and waste.

Our living is affluent with goods. And everyday, a lot of goods are produced, consumed and disposed. However, the Earth's resources are limited. For the future of the Earth, we have to try not to waste things and aim at realization of a recycling-based a society where limited resources are recycled.

Let's take a second look at our lives and tackle the reduction of waste as a firsthand effort.

The key words to reduce waste are the three Rs. **Reduce waste with the 3Rs!** We will be able to reduce waste with a little bit of effort.

The 1st **R** is Reduce

Don't throw out garbage

- \therefore Give old clothes, etc. to people, or put them out to the city's collection point.

Use rehabilitated items

Let's put it to practice!

- Δ Let's follow the rules and correctly segregate recyclable materials from garbage.
- \therefore Let's remove dirt from plastic containers and the like with old cloth and waste water before disposing them on the day for recyclable plastics.
- \therefore Let's actively buy recycled products.



Use Minato Eco Shops!

Minato Eco Shops are retail stores in Minato City that are actively engaged in reducing waste and recycling. A list of Minato Eco Shops and their respective efforts is available on the official Minato City website. Use Minato Eco Shops regularly for eco-friendly shopping.

What is "food loss" ?

Food loss refers to food that is disposed of as waste even though it is still safe to eat, such as leftovers, vegetable skin peeled too thickly during cooking preparation, and foodstuffs that have passed their best-by dates. In Minato City, of the combustible waste collected by the City, about one-third of household waste and one-second of business waste (from companies and restaurants) is raw garbage that includes food loss. Minato City aims to reduce combustible waste by working towards minimizing food loss.

Efforts to reduce food loss at home

Household 30/10 ("Sanmaru-Ichimaru") Program

The 30th of Every Month "Refrigerator Cleanup Day"

Periodically check the foodstuffs in your storeroom and refrigerator.
 Avoid buying foodstuff in bulk, and purchase what you need in necessary amounts.

The 10th of Every Month "Mottainai Cooking Day"

- Using vegetable skins and leftover vegetable pieces that would otherwise have gone in the trash, remake leftovers into another dish.
- Practice cooking methods that use up foodstuffs.

Party 30/10 ("Sanmaru-Ichimaru") Program

At parties and other gatherings, people tend to move to different seats and get so engaged in conversations that lots of food can be left over. This program aims to prevent such wasteful behavior and work on enjoying and finishing up dishes.

Food-enjoying time

During the first 30 minutes following the toast, enjoy the freshly made meal.

Finishing-up time

Make the last **10 minutes** of wrapping up a time to prioritize eating.





Finishing-up Promotion Month (Dec. 16 - Jan. 15, Mar. 16 - Apr. 15)

Minato City promotes the reduction of food loss under the slogan **"Mottainai! Enjoy and Eat Up Food"** with "Finishing-up Promotion Month" twice a year during the wintertime year-end and New Years and in the spring, which are the times when food loss is most likely to occur due to home parties and other special occasions.



In the ward, restaurants that are actively reducing food loss, such as by introducing small serving menus, are registered as 'Stop Food Loss Partner Restaurants'.

Please separate the recyclable plastics from waste

Recyclable plastics collected in the City are transported to the Minato Recycling Center. The staff pick out objects that are unsuitable for recycling by hand from the large amount of plastics. The remaining plastics are compressed and packaged into bundles called a "bale" and transported to privately-run recycling plants for recycling. Private plants conduct a bale inspection, where bales are checked for any unrecyclable objects, in which case the plants may reject the bale.

To ensure that your plastics are recycled, the City asks for your cooperation with proper sorting.

How to put out recyclable plastics

 Organize all and only recyclable plastics into a lidded container or a see-through bag to put them out for collection. Do not double-bag. The collected bags of recyclable plastics are torn at the Minato Resource Recycling Center to check the contents for any inclusion of unrecyclable objects.

Using smaller bags inside the plastics garbage bag requires extra work to tear these smaller bags; therefore, please do not double-bag the garbage bags for recyclable plastics.

Please be aware of unsafe items that you cannot put out as recyclable plastics!

Razors, batteries, lighters, cutting tools, and injection needles and other medical waste found among collected recyclable plastics are called "unsafe items," which are dangerous when working with recyclable plastics at recycling plants. These unsafe items have been found in recent quality inspections from recyclable plastics collected from homes in Minato City.

If the inclusion of such unsafe items continues, recycling recyclable plastics will become more costly. Please do NOT put unsafe items out as recyclable plastics.

If you need to use a container for bottles and/or cans, please apply to the Minato Recycling and Waste Management Office. Bottles and cans put inside a container are collected with the container, and another folded container is placed in the collection center. In places where containers can get in the way of traffic, such as on the sidewalk, the manager of the collection center should immediately put away the containers.

Regional organizations such as the neighborhood association, PTA or administrative cooperative composed of more than 10 households of its residents may undertake collection of recyclable materials themselves, and hand them over to a recyclable collection and processing company. In this manner efforts are being put into reduction of volume and recycling of garbage.

Used paper (excluding industrial waste) from small enterprises that meet the criteria of the Small and Medium Enterprises Basic Act (see below) can also be collected.

Small enterprises that meet the criteria of the Small and Medium Enterprises Basic Act Manufacturing, etc.: 20 employees or less Commerce/Service, etc.: 5 employees or less

Please contact the Collaboration Project Section of each Regional City Office before starting the group collection.

Note

Should you switch from group collection to district collection, please consult with the Minato Recycling and Waste Management Office beforehand. In addition, we may not be able to accomodate a switchover in the middle of a fiscal year. Thank you for your understanding.

The City reinforces patrols to prevent taking away of recyclable items and control offenders.

Minato City revised the "Minato City Ordinance on the Processing and Reuse of Waste" and prohibited the act of taking away recyclable items from recyclables and waste collection sites within the City.

Please utilize group collections.

It is effective in preventing taking away of recyclables because groups directly manage them.

There have been instances of waste being abandoned at night in Minato City. Please refrain from placing waste at collection sites the night before collection date.

The waste collection traders, who are entrusted to collect recyclable items by the City, paste stickers on the cars (see the photo on the right) and start collection after 8:00 am. Further, collectors of the recyclable items always wear working clothes and work in a pair.

Garbage trucks compress the waste they carry. When flammable gases such as ones in spray cans, etc., and lithium-ion batteries and button type batteries, etc. enter a garbage truck, they may ignite and cause a fire in the garbage truck from the friction between metals. Please observe the above rules to prevent fires in the garbage trucks.

 - (4) There are dangers or risks involved in pick-up
 - (5) If you have to move (if your points are low or you have enough time before moving), we may be able to collect it.

Contact guidance

The staff, while talking with people of the district, are making efforts in improving their disposal methods and behavior. Those who have trouble following the segregation and collection days please consult the Minato Recycling and Waste Management Office.

Extra waste collection

When a great amount of waste has to be disposed at one time due to the

move of a household or pruning of trees, usual collection can not correspond to the need. Please consult the Minato Recycling and Waste Management Office. Do not take your waste directly to the Minato Recycling and Waste Management Office and Minato incineration plants.



About submitting waste which includes mercury

Garbage including mercury may cause stoppage in the incinerator at the waste plant. When submitting thermometers or manometers, please contact the Minato Recycling and Waste Management Office. A representative will collect directly from your home. Items submitted by businesses cannot be collected by the City.

Lending out bird preventive nets

In order to prevent crows and cats from scattering garbage at the waste collection site, the city lends out the bird preventive nets free of charge to the person who can take care of the collection

site. Apply to the Collaboration Project Section of each Regional City Office or Minato Recycling and Waste Management Office.



Waste collection locations

There are about 12,000 waste collection sites in the City and people in the community are voluntarily cleaning and keeping the dustbins in good condition. While locations of the waste collection sites and their users are determined based on opinions of the people in the community, the locations should be the places where collection can be conducted safely. Please consult the Minato Recycling and Waste Management Office on matters regarding collection sites.

How to dispose of recyclable items and waste from business activities

In principle, recyclable items and waste from business have to be disposed of at the responsibility of the business establishments.

Recyclables or waste discarded by businesses must be handled privately. Therefore, in principle, the City will not collect such waste. All businesses must request waste collection/processing by an authorized waste collection and transporting companies due to small amount of waste should inquire with the Minato Recycling and Waste Management Office. We will inform the companies which can collect and transport the waste.

Waste Management and Public Cleansing Act

Article 3 of the "Waste Management and Public Cleansing Act" establishes that "Businesses must assume responsibility for waste generated from their own business activities and carry out its proper processing." In addition, article 9 "Minato City Ordinance on the Processing and Reuse of Waste" estalishes that "The business must take responsibility of the waste from its business and process it properly."

Regarding the disposal of wastes from home care

We have the following for the disposal of wastes from home care

	Gauze, degreasing line, testing paper, diapers, IV bag, syringes, CAPD bag and its attached tube etc.
Incombustible waste	Empty medicine bottles, etc.
Injection needles	Return injection needles to the medical institution (hospital or clinic) that prescribed them, dispensing pharmacy, or home-visit nursing station.

- Things to remember when disposing of waste from home
- CAPD bags and other medical-use bags should be emptied, with the residue properly treated, before putting them out as combustible waste.
- When putting them in bags for disposal, please be careful not to tear the bags.

Site collection

Site-collection is a system in which the city uses collection boxes installed in each Regional City Office to collect small-sized home appliances, plastic bottle caps, used clothing, waste cooking oil, used fluorescent

lights and dry-cell batteries. Items are limited to household items. Locations of collection boxes are included in the Site-collection list on page 23.



Used small-sized home appliances (9 targeted collection items)

Some of small-sized home appliances disposed as incombustible waste contain useful metals (rare metals such as palladium or precious metal such as gold, silver, copper). Minato City utilizes these used small-sized home appliances effectively as resources and promotes recycling of useful metals.

How to dispose

Please dispose directly to the yellow collection boxes installed at 13 city owned facilities.

Collection of waste cooking oil

Let the waste cooking oil cool down to a room temperature and pour into an airtight container such as a plastic bottle using a funnel and close the cap tightly, and bring it to a place where a collection box is installed.

- * Limited to cooking oil only. Do not put oil other than cooking oil such as petroleum oil.
- * Cooking residue can be in the oil.

Collection of used fluorescent lights

Put straight tube/circle type fluorescent lights back into the original packages from the time of purchase or wrap them into newspaper to avoid getting broken, and bring them to a place where a collection box is installed. * Please dispose of broken fluorescent lamps as incombustible waste.

Collection of used dry-cell batteries

Dry-cell batteries are included in precious resources. Collection boxes are installed at each Regional City Office, library and Ikiiki Plaza in order to efficiently utilize that resource.



According to the Tokyo Fire Dept., when rechargeable batteries or button type batteries such as lithium ion batteries are compressed, they may emit smoke and sparks. When disposing of these types of batteries, there is risk of fire from the compression function in garbage trucks. Please dispose of rechargeable or button-type batteries such as lithium ion batteries by placing them in collection boxes at retail locations.

Recycling of dentures

Disused dentures can be recycled for social welfare.

After cleaning and sterilizing in boiling water and such, wrap it in a thick piece of paper, put it in a vinyl bag, and put it in a denture collection box (right photo) installed at the Minato Council of Social Welfare and each Regional City Office.

The metal part of collected dentures is refined, exchanged for cash and donated to the Minato Council of Social Welfare and UNICEF.

"It can still be used" "It would be a shame to throw it away!" Do you have these kinds of furniture just lying about your home? The city will collect unwanted wooden furniture in good condition, free of charge, after assessing the quality of each piece, in order to reduce the amount of large-sized waste and promote effective use of resources through reusing the furniture.

After simple cleaning and repairs, the collected furniture will be exhibited at the furniture recycling exhibition and will be sold for a fee to the first buyer. Each household may buy up to two pieces of furniture at a time. The selling price is anywhere between 1,000 yen and 10,000 yen, depending on the size and quality of the furniture.Deliveries are available to locations in Minato City and nearby districts.(transport of the item will be paid by buyer)



We will collect your good-quality unwanted household furniture.

How to Apply

All furniture must be assessed. Assessments will be made by prior appointment so please contact the "Furniture Recycling Exhibition Office," below.

Also, depending on screening results, collection may not be available of charge. We appreciate your understanding. Furthermore, collection may not be available free of charge if the location for collection is in at a floor over the 3rd floor and there is no elevator in the building, the load cannot be transported through the entrance, etc. We appreciate your understanding.

Let's stop food loss!

Food loss is food that is still edible but is thrown away.

The annual food loss in Japan is about 6.43 million tons^(*1). The amount of food aid for people suffering from hunger around the world is about 3.9 million tons per year^(*2), so about 1.6 times that amount is wasted.

What we can do

Practise the "3 alls" (use all, eat all, drain all the water)

To reduce food loss, it is effective to "use all" and "eat all". To reduce garbarge, let's work on the "3 alls" together with "drain all the water".

Use it all up!

Purchase only what you need, and use it up without waste!

- Before going out, check the refrigerator, and make a shopping plan
- Take advantage of buying things in small quantities, and avoid buying too much
- Freeze food to keep it, and use up all the ingredients

Eat it all up!

Let's enjoy food without leaving anything!

- Make only as much food as you can eat
- Re-use any food remaining in different ways

Orain it!

About 80% of garbage is water. Before you throw it out, drain all the water thoroughly

- Don't allow food ingredients to get wet
- Let garbage dry in a well-ventilated place before taking it out.
