

What sort of place is the Child Consultation Center?

The Child Consultation Center is a specialized consultation facility established according to child welfare laws and regulations, for children and the guardians of children.

Feel free to come for a consultation on any child-related issues you may encounter from pregnancy until the child becomes independent.

The Child Consultation Center provides consultations related to children.



Are you having any trouble with school, family, or daily life?

- The child has a headache or stomach ache every day, and they hate the thought of going to school.
- The child is being mistreated by friends or bullied.
- The child is worried about their friend's troubles (such as shoplifting or running away)
- The child is being abused at home or treated poorly compared to a sibling. The child is suffering and was told, "I wish you were never born!"
- The child doesn't want to go home, etc.

Do you have any worries or concerns about raising a child?

- I sometimes get frustrated and hit my child.
- The child displays problematic behavior (running away) or illegal behavior (violence, shoplifting).
- Unable to care for the child due to circumstances such as illness.
- I fear I know a family where abuse may be occurring and I want to find them the right support, etc.



We provide consultations on child development

- Intellectual or physical disabilities
- Delayed development of speech
- Ai-no-Techo (Certificate of the Intellectually Disabled) judgement, etc.



A specialist will support you in protecting the lives and rights of children!



Specialist staff provide support and guidance according to the issues of each individual child.



Why not become a foster parent?



There are children who are unable to live with their real parents due to many different reasons, such as illness or death of the parent or abuse. The foster parent program enables you to take on the care of those children and raise them in your home. The Child Consultation Center supports foster parents by providing childcare training and offering accessible consultation services that are available to you at any time.

The age of the foster children ranges from under 1 year old to just under 18, and the period of care can range from temporary care, lasting several days to several weeks, to long term care lasting years. Each case depends on the situation of the child and the conditions of the foster parents. Why not become a foster parent yourself so that every child may experience the warmth of a family environment?

The Child Consultation center also provides legal guidance and support on regular and special adoption for those who wish to become foster parents.
