# ● Fares, etc.

#### 100 yen per ride for those of elementary school age or older.

- When transferring routes, passengers must pay 100 yen for each route.
- Transportation IC cards may be used (but we do not sell these cards on the buses).

#### Free for preschool children (Free for up to two accompanying passengers who are school age or older).

- \*However, a fare must be paid by:
- (1) Unaccompanied preschool children
- (2) The third or more accompanying passenger who is school age or older.

#### Minato City Community Bus tickets may be used.

• Minato City-only free bus tickets are available for senior residents in the city.

(For details, contact the Health and Welfare Subsection, Residents Support Section of each Regional City Office.)

• Tokyo Metropolitan silver passes may not be used.

### Discount commuter passes are also available.

• For each route; 4,200 yen for one month/11,970 yen for three months \*Commuter passes may be reserved on the bus and received on a later day.

## One-day passes that can be used for both the Odaiba Rainbow Bus and Chii Bus are available (500 yen per pass).

- They are sold on the buses only on Saturdays, Sundays, National holidays, August 13 to 15, and December 29 to January 3.
- They may be used for all the Odaiba Rainbow Bus routes and Chii Bus routes.

# One-day transfer tickets, valid between Tamachi Station East Gate (Tamachi route) and Minato Park Shibaura, are available.

- For passengers using the Tamachi route, a one-day transfer ticket, valid from Tamachi Station East Gate to Minato Park Shibaura, is issued at Tamachi Station East Gate.
- When returning from Minato Park Shibaura, a one-day transfer ticket, valid for the Tamachi route, is issued at Tamachi Station East Gate.

### Vehicles

- Capacity: 56 passengers (26 seating and 30 standing positions) on mid-sized buses,
  - 35 passengers (11 seating and 24 standing positions) on small-sized buses.
- · Wheelchairs: Mid-sized buses can accommodate two wheelchairs,
  - Small-sized buses can accommodate one wheelchair.
- All buses are low-floor vehicles.

## Chii Bus requests of passengers

- All the seats on Chii Buses are priority seats. We ask passengers to give their seats to those who need them, such as the elderly, disabled persons or pregnant women.
- Passengers can board buses only at bus stops, and cannot, for example, board just after the bus has left a bus stop and is waiting at a traffic light.
- Passengers should not rush onto the bus, as this may cause accidents or injuries.
- Pets are not permitted on the bus, except for service dogs, hearing dogs and guide dogs.
- · Loading/unloading wheelchair passengers may take time. We ask for passengers' understanding and cooperation.
- Handle-type wheelchairs are not permitted on the bus for safety reasons.
- Passengers must prepare small change before getting on the bus. Bills of 2,000 yen or more will not be accepted.
- Passengers should set their mobile phones to silent mode and refrain from talking on the phone while on the bus.
- Passengers should remain seated until the bus has come to a complete stop, to prevent accidents.
- Smoking is not permitted at bus stops or on the bus.
