## Application may be Necessary for the Child Allowance, *Jido Teate*

With payments from October 2022, Child Allowance will not be paid when the income of the year 2021 of the person bringing up the child exceeds the income cap.

The amount of allowance varies depending on the child's age, number of children, and income of the applicant. If the income of the year 2022 of the person bringing up the child falls below the income cap after the person becomes unqualified to receive allowance, he/she will be required to submit a Child Allowance Authorization Application Form again.

Apply after 5/1, 2023, if the income of 2022 is lower than the income cap.

If the application was submitted during 5, 2023, allowance will be paid from 6, 2023.

\*Please note that if you delay your application, you will not be able to receive the allowance of the month that you delayed.

# **Issuance of My Number Card**

#### Greater convenience with My Number Card

My Number is a system used in Japan in the three areas of social security, taxes, and disaster measures. When making for resident certificate for the first time after arriving in Japan, a 12-digit My Number will be issued. You will also receive a personal number notification letter by post, informing your My Number.

My Number Card has an IC chip, which is needed for enhancing the convenience of life in Japan. In addition for using as an official identification document, the e-certificate installed in the IC chip can be used for e-Tax. Also, it can be used to obtain certificates at convenience stores, such as certificates of residence. Application is necessary for the issuance of My Number Card.

# **Vaccination Program Starts in Spring 2023**

The COVID-19 Vaccination program in Spring 2023 will start from 5/8, 2023.

#### **Date**

5/8 - 8/31

#### **Eligibility**

- 1. 65 years and older
- 2. 5 to 64 years with an underlying condition, or people assessed by a doctor to be at high risk of developing serious illness
- 3. Medical workers, people working at elderly facilities/facilities for people with disabilities

#### **Interval of vaccinations**

People who have received first and second vaccinations, and who received their last vaccination more than three months ago

Omicron Variant-adapted Bivalent vaccine
