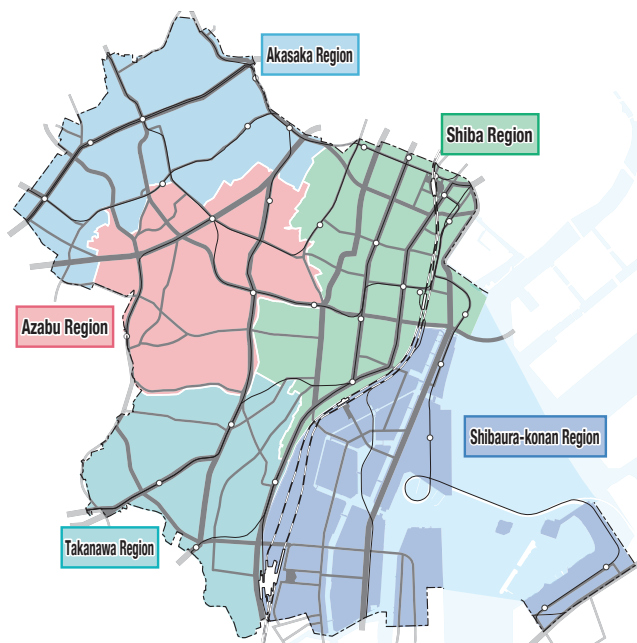


Policies for Regional Community Development

In order to specify individualized goals with respect to the characteristics and needs of each local region, we have divided the city into five different regions in which each region can present and achieve its own goals.



Goals for the Shiba Region

- ◆ Coexistence between various diverse commercial areas, business facilities, and residential districts.
- ◆ Reconstructing opportune global business locations while developing the transportation system.
- ◆ Safe and secure community development so that residents in the city can live in homes harmoniously, side-by-side with vibrant shopping streets.
- ◆ Preserving an environment where greenery, history and culture can be felt.
- ◆ Creating a lively community based on the creation of regional management practices.
- ◆ Preserving large green spaces and beautiful cityscapes.

Goals for the Azabu Region

- ◆ Community development with diverse international cultural backgrounds.
- ◆ Creating and maintaining a lively community where people from diverse backgrounds can gather.
- ◆ Community development for the coexistence of both pleasant residential districts and vibrant commercial districts.
- ◆ Improving the accessibility of transportation and developing a safe community.
- ◆ Expanding community development activities with community interaction.

Goals for the Takanawa Region

- ◆ Sustainability of pleasant residential areas with rich greenery.
- ◆ Improving the convenience of local transportation.
- ◆ Constructing a safe and secure community by strengthening disaster prevention management.
- ◆ Establishing a brand-new global district around the upcoming JR station and Shinagawa station.
- ◆ Promoting the maintenance and planning of urban thoroughfares.
- ◆ Promoting community development ideas inspired by local citizens.

Goals for the Akasaka Region

- ◆ Creating a lively cityscape influenced by its historic and cultural backgrounds.
- ◆ Developing a refined and lively cityscape.
- ◆ Building an accessible and beautiful city designed to appeal to both domestic and foreign visitors.
- ◆ Creating liveliness by utilizing tourism and cultural resources.
- ◆ Sustainable development of greenery.
- ◆ Improving disaster prevention management in communities.
- ◆ Improving our living environment by promoting the local community.

Goals for the Shibaura-konan Region

- ◆ Improving the living environment in response to population increase.
- ◆ Establishing a brand-new global district around the upcoming JR station and Shinagawa station.
- ◆ Maintaining a convenient and accessible transportation system.
- ◆ Upgrading disaster prevention management based on local needs and characteristics.
- ◆ Building an attractive city development using waterfront spaces.

Future Plan for Community Development

To achieve the goals for the city's future image, and its development, we will focus on these points.

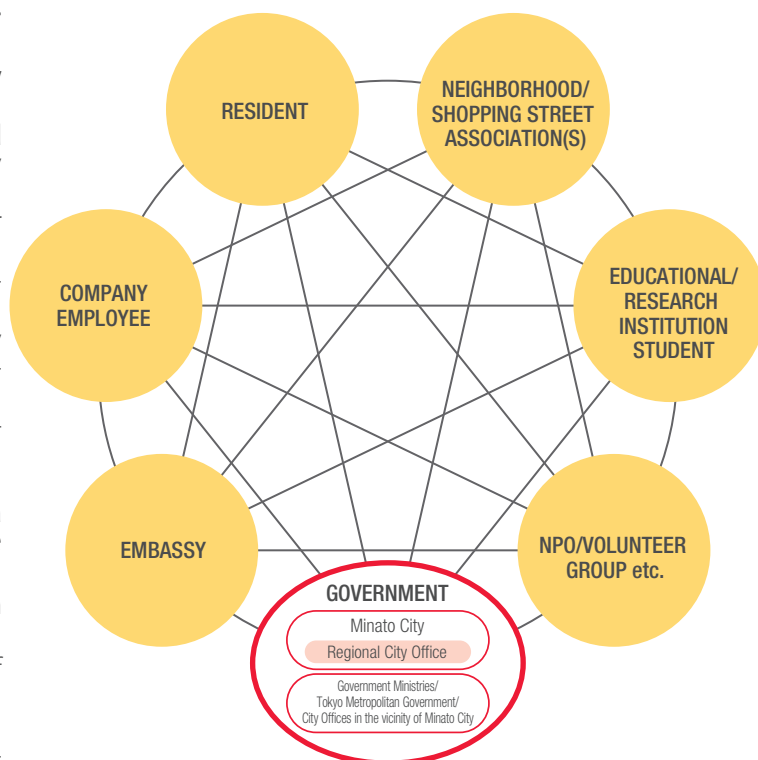
○ **Improving the collaborative system for community development.**

- 4) Efficient and comprehensive community development with both tangible and intangible elements.
- 5) Recruiting and educating individuals for community development.
- 6) Appropriate management of the existing facilities and maintenance of infrastructure via introducing and utilizing the vitality of private organizations.

○ **Achieving community development which can adjust to the changes of time**

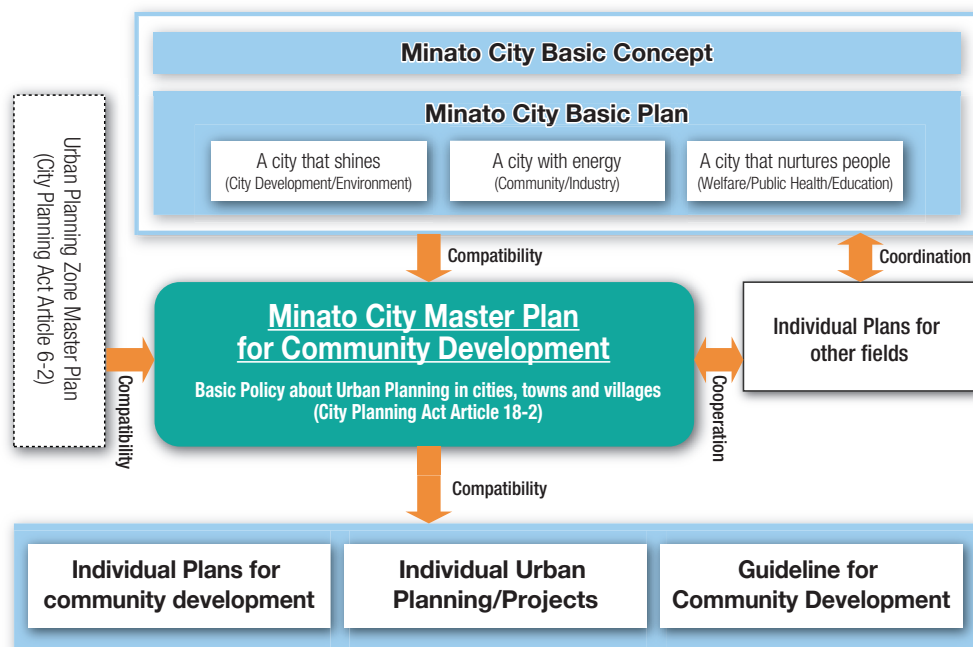
- 1) Promotion of the prompt development of relevant individual plans.
