


# **Summary of the Roppongi/Toranomon District Guidelines** for Community Development

In order to preserve high quality urban areas and promote integrated and deliberate urban development in the Roppongi/Toranomon District, the "Roppongi/Toranomon District Guidelines for Community Development" were formulated in December 2012, representing the future vision of the community and the policy for community development. About 10 years have passed since the guidelines were made, and the environment of the community has changed significantly, so we have made revisions.

#### ■ Target District

This district has an area of about 75 hectares, and is surrounded by Gaien-higashi-dori St., Sotobori-dori St., Sakurada-dori Ave., Roppongi-dori Ave., and Azabu-dori St.



#### Chapter 2: Background of the Community (p.5-32)

#### **■**Community Development Trends

- Osince the guidelines were formulated (in December 2012), multiple large-scale developments using urban planning have made progress, and international lodging facilities, offices, urban housing, and other central functions have concentrated in the district.
- OIn this district, infrastructure such as roads, sidewalks, open spaces, and green spaces have been developed through large-scale development, forming the backbone of the community.






#### Policy 1: Land use

### Policy 3: Roads and traffic (Pedestrian network)


We will establish "pedestrian paths" to revitalize excursions made by people in the area and promote our district's activities and interactions by connecting public plazas in the district.

In order to create a traffic environment in the district that everyone can use in safety and comfort, we will develop a road network connecting the north, south, east, and west areas of the district.


#### ■Policy Map (Road network)

#### Chapter 5: Area-specific community development policies (p. 76 – 85)

#### ■ Role of area-specific policies

In order to solve problems in each area and promote detailed community development that makes use of local characteristics, we have made consideration for the terrain, main roads, and areas where integrated community development is underway. Next, we divided the community into four areas sorting out the characteristics (appeal, properties, and issues) of each area, in order to indicate the direction of community development.

#### **≪Current status of each area and direction of community development≫**

#### ○North Area: Build an international business exchange hub with multiple stations nearby

- OWe will further promote the accumulation of urban functions, with the community as a base for international business exchange that makes the most of its local characteristics.
- OWe will guide international standard operations, medical care, business dissemination, MICE, and conferences, etc.
- OWe will develop a safe, comfortable and multilayered pedestrian network, including access from the surrounding areas.
- Oln addition to updating the urban functions around train stations, we will improve plazas that are directly connected to stations, and strengthen barrier-free movement lines.
- OAlong with this development, we will develop a bicycle sharing port around Tameike-Sanno Station.
- OFor One-michi St. and Akasaka/Toranomon Green Road, we will promote development of promenade open spaces with abundant greenery, in order to form large-scale green road spaces.


### ♦ East Area: Build a multi-purpose urban area with lush greenery close to work and housing

- OWith consideration for the unity of the district, we will build a multi-purpose urban area close to workplaces and residences, and work toward realizing coexistence in the living environment along the One-michi St. and international commercial and business area.
- OWe will develop the undeveloped block roads and ensure the continuity of the road network. We will also build a safe and comfortable pedestrian network adapted to terrain with elevation differences.
- OWe will seize the opportunity for community development in order to develop roads within the district through block reorganization, as well as strengthen the transportation network within the district, and develop a bicycle sharing port around Kamiyacho Station in conjunction with development.
- OWe will maintain and nurture pedestrian passages that cross the district from west to east, as high-quality, lush green spaces.
- OWith the pedestrian paths, we will build a continuous network of greenery.

#### the most of cultural facilities

- OThe west side of the area will be a multi-purpose urban area centered on business, commerce, and exchange functions, while the east side of the area will be a multi-use urban area rich in international, historical, and cultural features.
- OWe will develop roads that have not yet been developed, develop pedestrian spaces along roads in conjunction with community development, and build safe and comfortable pedestrian networks that with consideration for terrain that has differences
- OSeizing the opportunity for town development, we will develop roads within the district through block reorganization, and strengthen the traffic network within the district.
- OWe will maintain and nurture pedestrian passages that cross the district from west to east, as high-quality, lush green spaces.
- OWith the pedestrian paths, we will build a continuous network of greenery.

#### ♦ South Area: Build culture and exchange hubs where diverse people can be active

- OWe will build a multi-purpose urban area close to workplaces and residences, with consideration for the unity of the district.
- OWe will develop a comfortable living environment for foreign nationals by introducing housing and lodging functions that meet diverse needs, and also international education, medical care, support for daily life, and exchange functions.
- OWe will ensure the smooth passage of vehicle traffic and strengthen traffic node functions by developing the pedestrian network.
- OWe will create activity and interaction in the district by connecting and networking plazas and open spaces with pedestrian paths.
- OWe will develop integrated green spaces, while preserving and utilizing the greenery of temples, shrines and slopes.
- Oln the pedestrian paths, we will build a continuous network of greenery.
